



Tis the Season of Color



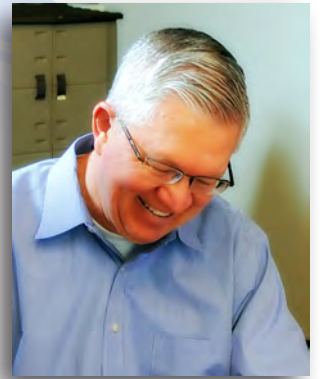
